a) Hay River Land Development Aspen Heights Sub-division

The Request for Proposals for Aspen Heights Subdivision Phase 1 and 2 closed on November 20, 2009. This development would provide 77 single family residential lots, 26 mobile home residential lots and 3 open space park areas. The Town received 6 construction proposals they are listed below in order of cost:

and one proposal to develop the subdivision through a third party.

Director of Public Works, Michael Richardson met with AECOM, the engineering firm that issued the RFP to initiate the evaluation process. The RFP requires that a decision be rendered on of before February 18, 2010.

Prior to the meeting with AECOM there was discussion about the proposed development with regard to the financial impact it would have on the Town. As a result Corvus Business Advisors attended the meeting with AECOM and the Town to discuss the proposed subdivision. Based on the discussion Corvus Business Advisors were asked to submit a proposal describing the approach they would use to assess the viability of the Aspen Heights subdivision. Council agreed to enter into a contract with Corvus Business Advisors.

The report from Corvus Business Advisors is attached for review however the report is not for public release because it contains specific information from the construction proposals and a decision has not been made regarding the proposed subdivision.

A decision respecting the Aspen Heights Subdivision must be provided by February 18, 2010 therefore Council will need to call a Special Meeting of Council to ratify its decision.
