A BY-LAW of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Hay River in the Northwest Territories pursuant to the Cities, Towns and Villages Act, S.N.W.T. 2003, c. 22 ("Cities, Towns and Villages Act"), to undertake a Local Improvements for the residents of this Town.

WHEREAS pursuant to section 58 of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act, a Municipal Corporation may, for a Municipal purpose, establish, deliver and operate services, in the form of installing curbs, gutters, sidewalks, paved surfaces and in the Town of Hay River in the Northwest Territories as shown in a sketch attached hereto as Schedule "A".

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 70 of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act, a council may make by-laws for Municipal purposes respecting public utilities, programs, services, infrastructure and facilities provided or operated by, or on behalf of, the Municipal Corporation and the enforcement of by-laws;

AND WHEREAS the improvements proposed will principally benefit real property as noted in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this By-Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HAY RIVER, in regular session duly assembled, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

This By-law may be cited as the "Local Improvements -Curb, Gutters, Sidewalk and Pavement"

PART 1 - INTERPRETATION

This by-law pertains to the McRorie Road improvements to include Curb, Gutters and Sidewalks. In this by-law the Local Improvement has been estimated at following terms:

- (1) That the Local Improvements in the areas described project in Schedule "A" attached hereto shall be implemented at the estimated project costs of eighty six thousand, six hundred and eighty dollars (\$86,680). This will include 17 properties of which the property owners will pay half of the total which is \$43,340. This represents the cost of 17 properties at \$2,549,00each.
- (2) That the total cost of the program payable by the Town of Hay River will be recovered by approximately forty three thousand, three and forty dollars (\$43,340.00) from the Town's Infrastructures Reserve, and approximately forty three thousand, three and forty dollars (\$43,340.00) recovered by assessing Local Improvement charges on the assessable lot distance described in Schedule "B" which is attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
- (3) That the property owners shall have the option to pay as follows:

- a) Prepay the total cost of the Local Improvement as outlined in Schedule "B" attached hereto, or
- b) Pay annual local improvement charges over a five (5) year period at four point zero (4.00%) per cent annual interest.
- c) Pay annual local improvement charges over a ten (10) year period at four point zero (4.00%) per cent annual interest.
- d) The outstanding principal may be repaid by the property owner at any time during the term of the debenture.

APPEALS

- (1) Any person served with an order made pursuant to section 5 of this By-law, may appeal the decision to Council within fourteen (14) days of the date of such order and the decision of Council on such an appeal shall be final subject only to any applicable provision of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act.
- (2) An appeal made under sub-section (1) shall:
 - (a) be in writing, stating the reasons for the appeal;
 - (b) be delivered to the Senior Administrative Officer; and
 - (c) be heard by Council at a Regular or Special Council meeting within twenty-one (21) days from the date it is received.

REPEALS - N/A

(1) Local Improvements By-law No. 2358/LIP/16 is a new Bylaw.

EFFECT

(1). Except where otherwise expressly stated in this By-law, this By-law shall come into effect upon receiving Third Reading and otherwise meeting the requirements of Section 75 of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act.
