Burning and Fire Permit

For the purpose of burning:

Burning shall be done in compliance with By-Law No. 1003, and any regulations made under and subject to the **FOLLOWING CONDITIONS**:

- 1) The permit holder shall be liable for all damage caused by him, his or her servants or agents, while acting under this permit.
- 2) There must be a clearance of at least 30 feet to any combustible material or buildings on all sides of the fire and that the permit holder shall ensure that suitable water protection such as coupled up hoses that will reach the area where the burning is to be done, is available.
- 3) At least two persons over the age of nineteen years must be in attendance to monitor the fire.
- 4) Burning shall not be conducted on a day when the wind exceeds 10 kilometres per hour.
- 5) The site shall be cleaned up and all hazards removed within seventy-two (72) hours of the burning.
- 6) Only brush (small trees and branches), leaves, grass, clean unpainted & untreated wood, household cardboard & paper may be burned.
- 7) The permit holder must contact the following and advise of the Permit No. and Location of Burning, prior to commencing:

This Burning and Fire Permit is subject to cancellation at any time by any member of the Hay River Fire Department, RCMP or an Environmental Protection Officer/Renewable Resource Officer, if he/she so feels that the conditions are not safe for burning.
