



Breakup Report for Sunday, April 26, 2020 @ 9:30am

Breakup is still moving along very slowly with a slow melt in all areas to the south of us and locally.

Weather for the few days

High Level area is trending at about 10 degrees higher than Hay River, the forecast in that area Sunday will be +2 with flurries Warmer weather is showing for Monday with a temp of +10 and +16 for Tuesday and Wednesday.

Hay River area Sunday -7 with a bit of snow in the morning. The forecast is for warmer weather starting on Monday with temperatures reaching +7 on Monday and +11 for Tuesday and Wednesday.

Water Levels

The Chinchauga river rose to 3 M yesterday and it is presently fluctuation between 2.5 – 3 M which indicates a jam somewhere downstream or an influx of water. We will keep an eye on this as the day progresses.

The water levels at the NWT Alberta Border are rising slowly and there is some snowmelt, but the ice is still in place. Levels at this time are still low.

There is fair snowmelt at the falls but levels are remaining constant, Paradise Valley is no9t showing any melt as of yet and levels are constant.

The water levels in Hay River are rising slowly.

The fact that the temperatures to the south of us are considerably warmer than local temperatures is a little concerning. Your EMO Team would like to remind you to ensure you are prepared for the possibility of an evacuation of the Old Town and Vale Island.

EMO personnel are monitoring the situation and will continue to advise of conditions as they develop.
