### Town of Hay River EMO Update

April 30, 2021 Breakup Report

The warming temperatures, along with precipitation in the form of rain and snow is helping the water levels rise along the southern NWT Watershed. At this point in time the rise is gradual, and we know that there has been no cracking or breaking of ice from the Hay River from Zama turnoff to Hay River.

Water levels in Sousa Creek area are still declining but the Chinchaga is starting to rise once again.

Locally we are seeing some surface water flow down the West Channel and buildups of surface water at the Pine Point Bridge, Paradise Valley and at the falls. We will be seeing temperatures rise in southern NWT over the next few days which should get things moving along a little faster.

EMO officials will be keeping an eye on the levels over the weekend and will be providing daily updates keeping you informed of any changes.
