

Flood Evacuation Preparedness Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

May 6th, 2021 Update

I live in the Hay River area and would like to know more about preparing for the annual Spring Breakup, where should I look?

• The Town of Hay River has created a website which includes Emergency Preparedness information, Emergency phone numbers and other information relating to spring Breakup. Details are available at www.hayriver.com/breakup.

Do I need to register during an evacuation?

 Yes – by phone at 833-699-0188 or at Hay River Community Centre (Recreation Centre). Those who are in Self Isolation or have COVID symptoms must call and not visit the Registration Centre.

When do I need to register?

Immediately after an Evacuation Order has been issued.

I live on Vale Island and am self-isolating at my home. In case of an evacuation what should I do?

• In the event of an evacuation due to flooding, residents of Vale Island who are required to self-isolate should contact the Registration Centre at 833-699-0188 after an Evacuation Order is issued.

What are my accommodation options if there is an evacuation?

- 1. Friends and Family
 - a. In compliance with COVID orders ie. 10 maximum per household
- 2. Community Centre Evacuation Centre
 - a. Cots and bedding provided
- 3. Community Centre RV Park
 - a. An RV Park has been setup at the Hay River Community Centre.
 - b. Pre setup is now available. Please call 833-699-0188 to arrange a setup time.
 - c. Community Centre RV park has 20amp powered circuits and refuse disposal. RV sewer dump and potable water available at the Visitor Information Centre
- 4. Commercial Accommodations (ie. Hotels)
 - a. Hotel costs are not covered



Will accommodation costs be covered during an evacuation?

• Free accommodations are provided to evacuees staying at the Community Centre Evacuation Centre. There is no reimbursement for private/commercial accommodations.

Will cost of meals be covered during an evacuation?

 Meals will be covered only for those who are staying at the Community Centre Evacuation Centre

What do I do with my pets?

- Bring your pets with you. Bring a kennel and leash.
- Recommendation is for residents to foster their pets with friends and family off-island if possible.
- Pets are NOT permitted to stay at the Community Centre Evacuation Centre.

What transportation is available from Vale Island during an evacuation?

 Transportation from Vale Island can be arranged for those with mobility issues and novehicular transportation. Contact the Registration Centre at 833-699-0188 to arrange for pickup if an Evacuation Order is issued.

Will my power be shutoff during an evacuation or a flood?

 If water levels become high enough, power will be shutoff for safety to people and properties
