 - ➤ snow loads in South Slave areas ranging from 109% to 140% of normal
 - Water conditions
 - Hay River basin high like last year

Committee role (Travis)

- Monitors
- Accessing them this week to start them and a high priority
 - Working to have Monitors hooked up sooner than last year.
 Monitors were not hooked up until the 29th last year.
- Clarify when response will be needed
 - ➤ Town is prepared for evacuation of vale island and able to support the evacuees for a short term. If major damages and flooding were to occur that would be when the CEMC would be needed for support.
- Identify departments for further discussion
 - o Health
 - Identify homecare-based patients or residents in need with mobility needs to pre-register and move earlier
 - o Infrastructure
 - Discussion on roles around highway closures and authority. Who will man the closure during the extent of the evacuation?



- Communicate current needs
 - Update contact information
 - > Add Highway Patrol (Steve Shelton) for Closure of highways if needed
 - > Should we add someone from Stittco and Midnight Petroleum in case of an emergency.
 - > Should have CN Rail added
 - Department heads
 - Decision makers
