Hay River Breakup Update

Wednesday May 4th, 2022 – 5pm

Last update provided was May 4th, 2022 at 10am.

Breakup of the Hay River is occurring between the Meander River bridge and the community of Meander River. No significant breakup of ice has occurred yet at the NWT/AB. River ice has broken and released at Alexandra Falls with water bank to bank upstream for a couple kilometers. High amounts of surface water are apparent on the West Channel and upstream through Paradise Gardens. River ice continues to remain mainly in tack through these areas.
