
Due to the location of the Hay River Riverside

Business License Final Reminder:

The 2021/2022, Town of Hay River business licenses have expired as of March 31, 2022.

The business license applications for 2022/2023 are **past due**. The applications to renew your business license are available at Town Hall.

As per The Town of Hay River's Business Bylaw No. 1395, any person or company operating within the Town limits must have a current business license. Any person operating without a valid business license is subject to a fine of up to \$500.00 plus court costs for the first offence. Any company operating without a valid business license is subject to a fine of up to \$1000.00 plus court costs for the first offence.

The grass and the trees are turning green, the weather has been beautiful. Our Golf Course is back operating, Fisherman's Wharf will open this month. Our softball club volunteers and town maintenance staff are working to clean up our fields. Campgrounds are open or opening soon and we are already starting to see seasonal tourists trickling into town. Capital projects are starting or continuing, some will move forward as planned, others will have to be differed or changed in response to the flood. As we come out of a very difficult May, let us use the signs of the approaching summer to remind us that with each passing season there comes a chance for renewal.

Renewal is what is on a lot of our minds these days after the most devastating natural disaster on record for our community. We experienced extensive flooding throughout - nearly 400 property owners have applied to the GNWT for damage assessments and financial disaster assistance. Core Town infrastructure also took significant damage. We do not yet know the financial impact of this disaster, as much of the restoration and remediation work is only just beginning. We do know it will be substantial. I have met with our Federal MP, the Premier and MLA's/ Cabinet, showing them firsthand the impacted areas of our community. The town has been and looks forward to continuing to work with our counterparts throughout the recovery and rebuilding stages, until we are back to 100% or beyond. We have a steep hill to climb, however I am confident that our community will do it together one step at a time.

Many of our friends and neighbours are still displaced, and many more that have lost priceless parts of their lives and livelihoods, so as we begin getting back into our routines, let us all keep that in mind and be kind to one another. There are far too many of you to thank in a brief letter but on behalf of myself and council, I want to say the most heartfelt thank you to everyone that has played a role during this challenging time, from those involved with the initial response to those involved in the recovery. Each of you are what makes our community the best place to live. When the dust settles I'm certain there will be an opportunity to properly recognize your efforts. Until then, let us focus on renewal.
