# Mayor's Message:

May's birth flower is Lily of the Valley but here in the North we await the arrival of the Spring crocus, bearberries, and of course the floral emblem of the North the Mountain aven. I know many of you are chomping at the bit to pick your seeds and to get out to your yards and flower beds for planting.

Of course, as with every spring we are all engaged with watching the snow melt and awaiting breakup. As most of you have heard we have experienced a high snow load this year with estimates of 130% normal. The water table remains high from last year and the winter water levels of the river and lake are above average as well. The Town's breakup planning team has been working for the last few weeks with stakeholders and residents to prepare for this year's spring breakup. As always preparedness is essential, and residents are directed to the Town's webpage for the latest information.

A few other highlights for May will see the draft Zoning Bylaw come to Council as well as the Terms of Reference for the Social Issues Committee. I had the opportunity to meet with the new owners of the Highrise at the end of April and they presented the high-level plans for the building. Housing concerns have been a major concern in the community. With the development of Fraser Place, Rows Apartments, and the eventual refit of the Highrise we are hopeful to see some easing of the housing shortage concerns. Also, the Town has donated a lot to Habitat for Humanity to build a home here in Hay River. The Town received a presentation from them last week and Steve Anderson is the community liaison for this project.

Let us all welcome spring this month by spending time outside enjoying the warmer weather and longer days.

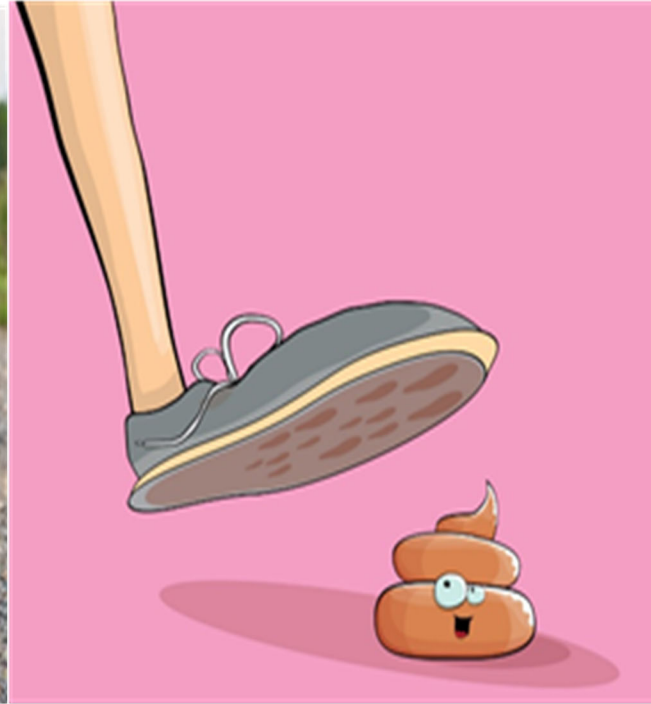

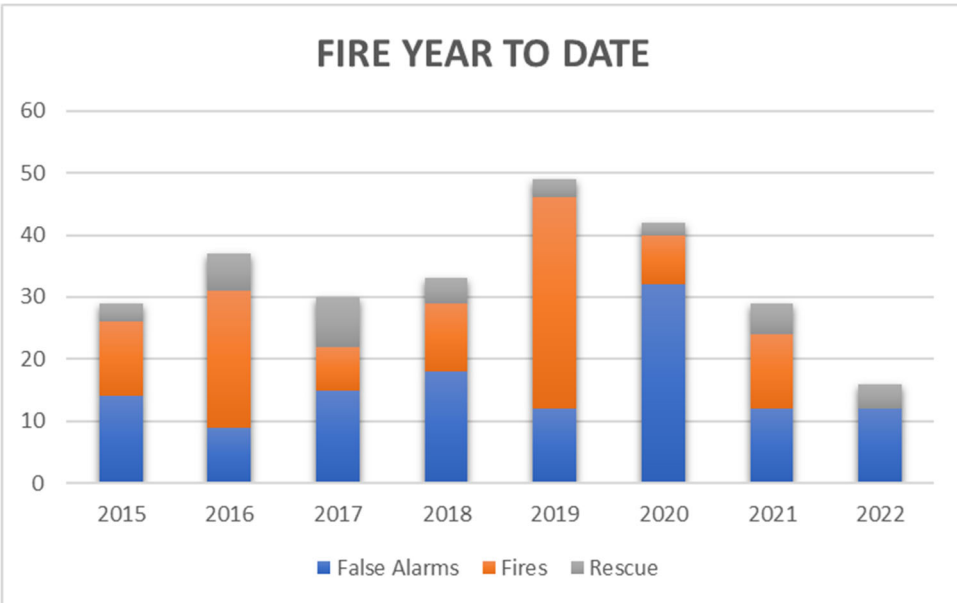

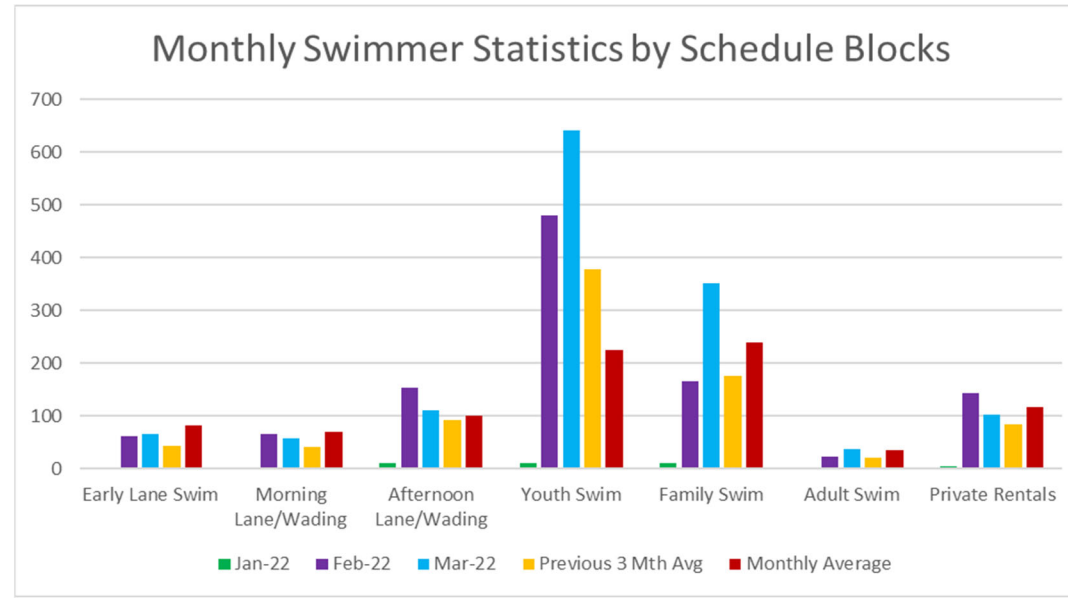

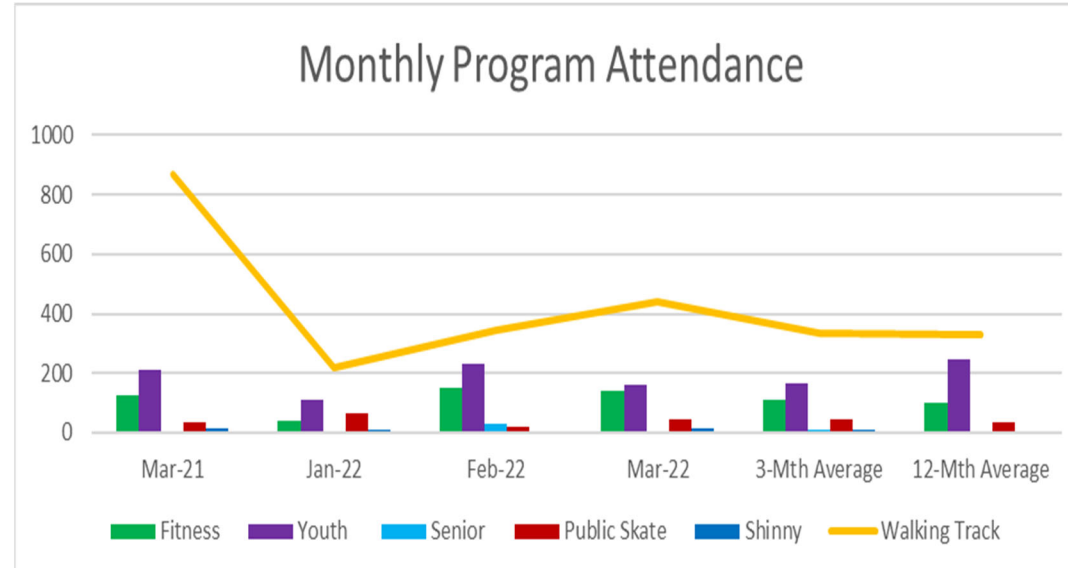
##### Monthly Swimmer Statistics by Schedule Blocks

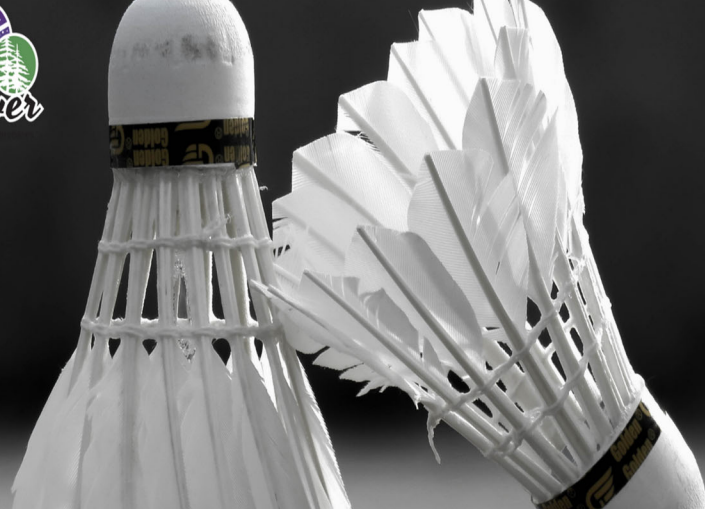
