SUBJECT: Flood Recovery Spend Approval

THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HAY RIVER approves the unbudgeted O&M and Capital spend of \$1,072,000 for unbudgeted flood response and high priority repair or replacement of flood damaged Town of Hay River assets as recommended by the Finance Committee of Council.

BACKGROUND:

The Town of Hay River incurred major damage to its infrastructure during the flood of 2022. Since the middle of May work has been undertaken to assess damage to these assets, and in some cases, undertake preliminary repair work to resume basic level of restoration.

On June 28, 2022, Council approved as information a damage assessment report that provided a preliminary summary of assets that had been damaged. Rough order estimates on costs to repair or replace damaged assets were included in the report as well as potential funding sources to cover these costs. The total cost estimate for Town infrastructure repairs and replacements related to the flood was \$22 million.

On July 6, 2022 Council's Finance Committee met to review flood recovery and response costs incurred to date and to discuss repair and replacement of damaged assets as well as mitigation activities ahead of securing third party funding. To date the Town has incurred approximately \$440,000 of unbudgeted asset repair/replacement expenses and \$97,000 of unbudgeted response costs for a total of \$537,000 of expenses. These expenses have been incurred through necessity to ensure effective emergency response, basic operation of essential Town services, and to protect the safety of residents.

Through the meeting, the Finance Committee has identified an additional \$535,000 worth of higher priority and/or opportune recovery/repair and mitigation work that is recommended to be undertaken in 2022 ahead of securing third party funding. This work considers operational need, public safety, recreational demand, and timeliness of work. There are several additional recovery/repair and mitigation opportunities that are being explored for third party coverage that are not included in the \$535,000 recommendation due to high cost risk (ie. West Channel Berm repairs, Water Treatment Plant Road raising).

Administration continues to advance discussions with potential funders, but more time is required to secure agreements through and beyond the 2022 construction season.
