- Firesmart Program talks with Wes Stead from ECC, update plan with projects. Each region will have a firesmart position.
- ECC risk triggers – worked through After Action Review
- Monitoring crew – send email today with dates for first meeting, get radios and access cards
- Roadway at airport will have equipment staged by infrastructure
- No data this year for ice thickness – new contractor next year
- Mutual aid agreement for KFN, Enterprise and Riverwoods being updated for emergency services including cost/fuel
